What is a Medical Home?

A medical home is a doctor's office that provides high quality care for your family. It provides common medical services like annual check-ups and sick visits. But you can also get other services you might need. A medical home helps you make the best plan for you and your family.

A Medical Home Is....

- 1 Comprehensive**
You get care for all your health needs.
- 2 Patient Centered**
The clinic helps you make the best choices for you and your family.
- 3 Coordinated**
The clinic connects you with other kinds of care. This includes hospitals and specialists for all your health needs.
- 4 Accessible**
Medical homes fit your schedule. They may have urgent care hours and night and weekend hours. Besides talking to them by phone, they may have on-line portals or other ways to get in touch.
- 5 Quality and Safety**
You need doctors you trust for your child's care. A medical home provides safe and high quality care for your family.

How much does a medical home cost?

It depends on your insurance and the type of clinic your family visits.

Have health insurance?

You can call your insurance to find a doctor near you!

- They can tell you about any costs you would pay.
- When picking a doctor, ask them if they are a patient centered medical home (PCMH).

Don't have health insurance?

- You can pay based on your income at Federally Qualified Health Centers.

Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs)
